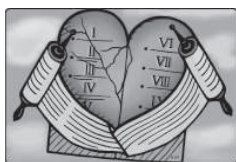

**THE CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY** is prayed every Wednesday in our Church at 3:00 p.m. **ALL ARE WELCOME.**

**IF THE MASS YOU ARE ATTENDING HAS A SPECIAL INTENTION FOR A FAMILY MEMBER**, and you would like to bring up the bread and wine, **please sit near where those gifts are placed on the table, and bring them up when the priest steps to the center of the Sanctuary.** Others seated near the gifts are asked to wait a minute to see if any family members step forward to bring up the gifts. If they don't, we ask two other people to bring them to the priest..

**A REMINDER FOR THOSE WHO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HAND.** Please remember to make a **throne for Our Lord** by placing one hand over the other, allowing the priest, deacon or Extraordinary minister of Holy Communion to **place the Host in the palm of your hand.** Then, you should consume the Host and make the sign of the cross before proceeding back to your pew. Please do not "take" or "grab" the Host from the minister but receive it in the palm of your hand.

**WHY DO YOU GENUFLECT TO THE TABERNACLE** (behind the Main Altar) **BEFORE GOING INTO YOUR SEAT BEFORE MASS AND BEFORE LEAVING YOUR SEAT?** The "Red Sanctuary Lamp" next to the Tabernacle indicates the presence of Jesus Christ. We genuflect on one knee before entering our pew as a **SIGN OF LOVE AND RESPECT** for the **REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE TABERNACLE.**

**HOLY NAME SCHOOL**

*We have some very pleasant news to share; our Title I allocation this year is more than 3 times last year's.* This is due to changes in Federal guidelines and regulations along with our being able to use our E-Rate income eligibility figures. Over the next few weeks we will share the areas in which we are using Title I Funds. They include:

The availability of a counselor - Dr. Anne Davidge, a licensed psychologist in Rhode Island and Massachusetts with 25 years experience, will be visiting Holy Name School for two hours each Monday for the next 4 to 5 months. Dr. Davidge has worked with Portsmouth Abbey and its students for the past four years; she specializes in treatment of children and families as well as adults. Areas of interest and expertise include child and adults ADHD, anxiety disorders, divorce related issues, depression and mood disorder, family therapy and much more.
