We genuflect on one knee before entering our pew as a **SIGN OF LOVE AND RESPECT** for the **REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE TABERNACLE.**

**HOLY NAME SCHOOL**

**As we prepare for Thanksgiving, all of the students, faculty and staff of Holy Name School extend to all the parishioners and their families gratitude for all your support and help. It is our prayer that God rewards you with His finest graces and blessings.**

Holy Name School will hold its **6<sup>th</sup> Annual ChipStrong Walk-a-thon** on Wednesday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> from 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. We are collecting canned goods and used winter coats; all of which will be donated to the St. Bernadette's Food Pantry.

*We are excited to share that the re-wiring for our expanded WIFI capacity began on Monday afternoon, November 13<sup>th</sup>.* The re-wiring is part of the Diocesan WiFi upgrade which was offered to all interested schools. With our expanded use of technology, we were pleased to be part of the diocesan program.

*We have some very pleasant news to share; our Title I allocation this year is more than 3 times last year's.* This is due to changes in Federal guidelines and regulations along with our being able to use our E-Rate income eligibility figures. Areas in which we are using Title I Funds include:

Afternoon Tutoring - Tutoring will be arranged on a four to one basis - 4 students to 1 teacher. We hope to be able to offer one or two tutoring groups each day. This program will also be extended to the elementary grades and early elementary grades as teachers agree to participate.
