**ASH WEDNESDAY** is this Wed., February 14. Mass will be celebrated at 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. There will be a Liturgy of the Word at 4:00 p.m. **Ashes will be distributed at all three times.** The collection taken up on Ash Wednesday is for the Work of Evangelization, or spreading the Gospel message, especially to people who haven't had the chance to **hear the Good News of Jesus.**

## THE SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

**FASTING AND ABSTAINING FROM MEAT DURING LENT:** A reminder of the Regulations of our Catholic Faith during the Season of Lent. All adults (18 or older) are bound to the **Law of Fasting** until the start of their 60th year. **FASTING DAYS** are those on which we should limit ourselves to **one meatless meal** and two smaller meals without meat. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting.** Those 14 and older are obliged to observe the **Law of Abstinence from Meat on Ash Wednesday and ALL THE FRIDAYS OF LENT.**

**OUR HOLY NAME ADULT FAITH FORMATION SERIES,** with Deacon Dan Nunes and Mr. Patrick McNabb, Director of Faith Formation, will host a **four part Education Series** this Lent based on the program *Seven Deadly Sins, Seven Lively Virtues.* From Bishop Robert Barron, who created the acclaimed *Catholicism* Series, his new series will discuss the seven deadly sins, those great **spiritual blocks** that inhibit our flourishing relationship with God and one another.
