FAITH FORMATION

SACRAMENTS AT HOLY NAME: The schedule for the reception of Sacraments in our Faith Formation Program is as follows: **First Holy Communion Rehearsal:** Tuesday, May 1 @ 6:00 p.m. in Church; **Sacrament of First Holy Communion:** Saturday, May 5 @ 11:00 a.m. in Church; **Confirmation Rehearsal:** Sunday, May 20; 5:00 p.m. Mass followed by Rehearsal at 6:00 p.m.; **Sacrament of Confirmation:** Monday, May 21, at 7:00 p.m.

ALL STUDENTS IN GRADES 1, 2, 8 & 9 who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **must sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon)**, whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well). If you attend Mass at another Catholic Church on a particular weekend, you must ask the priest who celebrates that Mass to sign a bulletin for you and bring it to Patrick McNabb at the Faith Formation Office.
