ON THIS FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI WE WOULD DO WELL TO REMEMBER: The Eucharist is the **Source and Summit** of the church's life, for in it, Jesus associated His members with His sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving. By the consecration at Mass, the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the **BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST** is accomplished. As **SACRIFICE**, the Eucharist is also offered in reparation of the sins of the living and the dead and to obtain spiritual and temporal benefits. **Any Catholic person DESIRING TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION WORTHILY MUST BE IN THE STATE OF GRACE.** Since Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist, it is to be honored with the worship of Adoration (as we do in Our Lady of Grace Chapel, Mon. - Fri.). **Participation in the Eucharist (Mass) is a testimony of belonging and being faithful to Christ and His Church. He is the one who told us to "DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME". Those who deliberately fail in the obligation to participate in Mass on Sunday (or Saturday after 4:00 p.m.) commit a grave sin and must go to Confession before receiving Holy Communion again.** Please see Fr. A REMINDER FOR THOSE WHO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HAND. Please remember to make a **throne for Our Lord** by placing one hand over the other, allowing the priest, deacon or Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion to **place the Host in the palm of your hand**. Then, you should consume the Host and make the sign of the cross before proceeding back to your pew. Please do not "take" or "grab" the Host from the minister but receive it in the palm of your hand.

WHY DO YOU GENUFLECT TO THE TABERNACLE (behind the Main Altar) **before going into your seat before Mass?** The "Red Sanctuary Lamp" next to the tabernacle indicates the presence of Jesus Christ. We genuflect on one knee before entering our pew as a **SIGN OF LOVE AND RESPECT** for the **REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE TABERNACLE.**

PARENTS OF CHILDREN ENTERING FIRST GRADE THIS FALL, IN EITHER PAROCHIAL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL are asked to call Patrick McNabb, our Director of Faith Formation, at **508-678-7532.** We will then put you on our mailing list regarding your child's preparation to **receive First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Holy Communion.** This preparation **begins at the start of their 1st grade and goes for 2 years.** If you are not sure whether or not you are registered members of Holy Name Parish please call Diane at 508-679-6732. She will be able to help you.

ALL STUDENTS CURRENTLY IN GRADES 1 & 8 who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **must sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon),** whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well). If you attend Mass at another Catholic Church on a particular weekend, you must ask the priest who celebrates that Mass to sign a bulletin for you and bring it to Patrick McNabb at the Faith Formation Office.
