HOLY NAME FAITH FORMATION: **REGISTRATION PACKETS FOR FAITH FORMATION CLASSES** have been mailed out. If you had a child registered in Faith Formation last year and **did not receive a packet in the mail**, please contact Patrick McNabb at the Faith Formation Office (508-678-7532), so one can be mailed to you. Parents of students entering Grades 1 or 8 **IN ANY SCHOOL (Catholic, Public or Private)**, if you did not receive a registration packet, please contact Patrick McNabb to have your child(ren) placed into the mailing data base so they can be registered in the Faith Formation Program to **begin a TWO YEAR** program for First Penance/First Eucharist and Confirmation respectively.

PARENTS OF CHILDREN ENTERING FIRST GRADE THIS FALL, (IN EITHER PAROCHIAL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL) are asked to call Patrick McNabb, our Director of Faith Formation, at **508-678-7532**. We will then put you on our mailing list regarding your child's preparation to receive **First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Holy Communion**. This preparation **begins at the start of their 1st grade and goes for 2 years**. If you are not sure whether or not you are registered members of Holy Name Parish please call Diane at 508-679-6732. She is able to help you.

ALL STUDENTS WHO WILL BE ENTERING GRADES 2 & 9 who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **NEXT YEAR** must **sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon)**, whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well). If you attend Mass at another Catholic Church on a particular weekend, you must ask the priest who celebrates that Mass to sign a bulletin for you and bring it to Patrick McNabb at the Faith Formation Office at school.
