**HOLY NAME SCHOOL**

Although Holy Name School presently has two Chrome book carts and 58 Chrome books, we will be ordering a minimum of 60 additional Chrome books and 2 more Chrome book carts in order to meet the testing requirements of this new educational initiative. Chrome books are also used throughout the school for writing and other Language Arts and Social Studies assignments. This academic year all of the parochial schools in the diocese are also implementing new Mathematics programs – Engage New York will be used with students in Kindergarten through Grade 5, and Open Up Resources will be used with students in the Middle School. The new Mathematics programs also will have the students working on Chrome books. In a very short period of time Holy Name School as well as other elementary educational institutions will need to have one electronic device available for each student in Kindergarten through Grade 8.
