RESPECT FOR LIFE MONTH: During the month of October, the Church throughout the U.S. commemorates **RESPECT FOR LIFE MONTH.** This year's theme is **EVERY LIFE: CHERISHED, CHOSEN, SENT.** As Catholics, this is a great opportunity to pause and remember the important role each of us has in **actively promoting and defending God's gift of human life in all its stages, from conception until natural death.** Remember that as long as we live in a nation whose law does not protect the most innocent of life, the unborn, we cannot have true peace. Pray the Rosary for a change in heart that people may respect all stages of human life.

IN SUPPORT OF LIFE: Decisions against human life are often influenced by feeling afraid, unsupported, pressured, or alone.
