THE FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

WHY DO YOU GENUFLECT TO THE TABERNACLE (behind the Main Altar) **BEFORE GOING INTO YOUR SEAT BEFORE MASS?** The “Red Sanctuary Lamp” next to the Tabernacle indicates the presence of Jesus Christ. We genuflect on one knee before entering our pew as a **SIGN OF LOVE AND RESPECT** for the **REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS IN THE TABERNACLE**.

A REMINDER TO THOSE WHO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HAND. Please remember to make a **throne for Our Lord** by placing one hand over the other, allowing the priest, deacon or Extraordinary minister of Holy Communion to **place the host in the palm of your hand**. Then, you should consume the host and make the sign of the cross before proceeding back to your pew. Please do not “take” or “grab” the Host from the minister but receive it in the palm of your hand.

HOLY NAME FAITH FORMATION
