**JOIN US THIS WEEK, MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY, APRIL 8 - 11,** for our **ANNUAL FALL RIVER AREA LENTEN MISSION**, led this year by Father Jose Eduardo Medeiros, MPS. The theme of this year's Mission is **"LIVING THE GOSPEL AS A PERMANENT WAY OF LIFE - A LENTEN JOURNEY OF COMMITMENT, TRUST AND RENEWAL."** The Mission will take place each evening at 7:00 p.m., preceded by Confessions at 6:00 p.m. (Several priests will be available each night.) The dates and locations of the Mission are as follows: **Mon., April 8** at St. Joseph Church, 1335 No. Main St., Fall River; **Tues., April 9** at St. Louis de France Church, 56 Buffington St., Swansea; **Wed., April 10** at St. Bernard Church, 32 So. Main St., Assonet; and **Thurs., April 11** at St. Anthony of the Desert Church, 300 No. Eastern Ave., Fall River. This Mission will also be given each day at 12:05 p.m. during Mass at St. Mary's Cathedral. We encourage you to **clear your calendar to make it possible for you to attend as many nights as you can to help you grow in your Faith. INVITE FAMILY MEMBERS AND FRIENDS. SPREAD THE WORD.** It is a way to fulfill your mission to bring the Good News of Jesus to others.

**PLAN TO RECEIVE THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION DURING LENT.** The Sacrament is available here every Saturday at 3:15 p.m., at all sessions of this week's **LENTEN MISSION** (see schedule above), several times during Holy Week, or by calling the Rectory to make an appointment with Fr. Jay or Fr. Daniel.

**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** will be prayed here **this Friday, April 12 at 6:00 p.m.** The Stations will also be prayed on **Good Friday, April 19 at 3:00 p.m.** We encourage everyone to take part in this spiritually enriching prayer of the Church.

**FASTING AND ABSTAINING FROM MEAT DURING LENT:** A reminder of the Regulations of our Catholic Faith during the Lenten Season. All adults (18 or older) are bound to the **Law of Fasting** until the start of their 60th year. **FASTING DAYS** are those on which we should limit ourselves to **one meatless meal** and two smaller meals without meat. **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting.** Those 14 and older are obliged to observe the **Law of Abstinence from Meat on Ash Wednesday and ALL THE FRIDAYS OF LENT.**

**EASTER FLOWERS:** Anyone wishing to donate for Easter Flowers in memory or honor of a family member or friend is asked to write the name(s) on the appropriate envelope that you have in your Budget packets and/or can find at the entrances of Church. Please turn it into us as soon as possible.

## THE FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT

**ALTAR SERVERS, LECTORS AND EXTRAORDINARY MINISTERS OF HOLY COMMUNION** are asked to come to the Sacristy after Mass today to sign up to **serve for Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.** Your service is appreciated.

**WE ARE LOOKING FOR PEOPLE TO VOLUNTEER TO HAVE THEIR FOOT WASHED** (in imitation of Our Lord washing the feet of the Apostles) for our **HOLY THURSDAY MASS** on **April 18.** The Mass is at 7:00 p.m. and volunteers are **asked to come to the Sacristy NO LATER THAN 6:40 P.M.** to receive brief instructions and be shown your reserved seat. This is a **Sacred Part of the Mass of the Lord's Last Supper** but we need people to step forward to help us have this important part of our celebration. See Fr. Jay or Fr. Daniel if you have any questions.

**PLAN AHEAD** to participate in our Holy Week Observances. On **Monday, April 15,** we have our **Lenten Penance Service at 6:30 p.m.,** where several priests will be available for Confession; on **Tuesday, April 16,** the Bishop and priests will **celebrate the Annual Chrism Mass** at 4:00 p.m. at St. Mary's Cathedral, where the Sacramental Oils will be blessed and the priests will renew the promises they made the day they were ordained. **ALL ARE WELCOME TO THIS MASS.** On **Wednesday, April 17,** there will be the ancient **TENEBRAE SERVICE** at Church at **7:00 p.m.** This is the most sacred week of our year. **PLEASE JOIN US.** The schedule for the **Sacred Triduum (3 days) Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, will be published next week.**

**OUR ANNUAL EASTER BREAKFAST AND EGG HUNT** will be on Saturday, **APRIL 20!!** The breakfast will run from 9 a.m. - 10 a.m., followed by the Egg Hunt. Tickets for the breakfast are \$6.00 for Adults and \$4.00 for children **10 and under.** The **Egg Hunt is free of charge** and is open to all children **10 and under.** Order forms for the breakfast are available at the entrances of Church and at Holy Name School.
