The new Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us of the following: **“We are obliged as Catholics to confess our sins AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR and to receive Holy Communion during the Easter Season (from Easter Sunday to Pentecost).”** The Church encourages us to receive Holy Communion, if we are properly disposed, each time we participate in Mass.

A SPECIAL BLESSING ON EASTER MONDAY. Through the Knights of Columbus, our Diocese of Fall River will be blessed on Easter Monday to have in our presence the heart of St. John Vianney (the Patron Saint of Priests). On EASTER MONDAY NIGHT, APRIL 22, the heart of St. John Vianney will be at St. Mary's Cathedral. Mass will be celebrated at 7 p.m. followed by the opportunity to venerate this Relic until 10 p.m. Plan to be present for this extraordinary opportunity. The next day, April 23, the heart will be present for veneration in the morning followed by Mass at 12:05.

IF YOU HAVE A FAMILY MEMBER AND/OR FRIEND who can no longer get to Mass each week BUT WOULD LIKE TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION AT HOME, please call our Parish Office and let us know. HOLY NAME FAITH FORMATION: ALL STUDENTS WHO ARE IN GRADES 1 & 2 and 8 & 9 who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **THIS YEAR OR NEXT** must **sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon)**, whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well).
