SACRAMENTS AT HOLY NAME: The schedule for the reception of Sacraments in our Faith Formation program is as follows: **Confirmation Rehearsal:** Sunday, May 19: 5:00 p.m. Mass followed by Rehearsal at 6:00 p.m.; **Sacrament of Confirmation:** Monday, May 20, at 7:00 p.m.

ALL STUDENTS WHO ARE IN GRADES 1, 8 & 9 who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **THIS YEAR OR NEXT** must **sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon)**, whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well). If you attend Mass at another Catholic Church on a particular weekend, you must ask the priest who celebrates that Mass to sign a bulletin for you and bring it to Patrick McNabb at the Faith Formation Office at school. **THIS APPLIES TO ALL STUDENTS IN THESE GRADES REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY ATTEND SCHOOL.**
