ON THIS FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI WE WOULD DO WELL TO REMEMBER: The Eucharist is the Source and Summit of the church's life, for in it, Jesus associated His members with His sacrifice of praise and thanksgiving. By the consecration at Mass, the transubstantiation of bread and wine into the BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST is accomplished. As SACRIFICE, the Eucharist is also offered in reparation of the sins of the living and the dead and to obtain spiritual and temporal benefits. Any Catholic person DESIRING TO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION WORTHILY MUST BE IN THE "STATE OF GRACE". Since Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist, it is to be honored with the worship of Adoration (as we do in Our Lady of Grace Chapel, Mon. - Fri.). Participation in the Eucharist (Mass) is a testimony of belonging and being faithful to Christ and His Church. He is the one who told us to "DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME". Those who deliberately fail in the obligation to participate in Mass on Sunday (or Saturday after 4:00 p.m.) commit a grave sin and must go to Confession before receiving Holy Communion again.
