Ask the Harvest Master to send workers into the Vineyard through the Sacrament of Holy Matrimony, the Consecrated Religious Life (as a Sister or Brother), the dedicated single life or the Sacrament of Holy Orders (as a Priest or Deacon).

AS WE HAVE ENTERED INTO THE ORDINARY TIME of our Church's year, we hopefully desire to be free from sin and able to follow the Lord each day, strengthened by the worthy reception of Holy Communion. Remember, as Catholics **WE HAVE THE PRIVILEGE AND RESPONSIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN MASS EVERY SUNDAY (or Sat. afternoon at the Vigil Mass).** This is because Jesus told us: **"DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME"**. It is a serious sin to miss Mass on Sunday or a Holy Day of Obligation for reasons other than sickness. If you have missed Mass **you should receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) BEFORE receiving Holy Communion.** Please see our schedule for confessions or call Fr. Jay or Fr. Daniel for an appointment.

SUMMER LECTURE SERIES AT BRISTOL COMMUNITY COLLEGE. Once again BCC is presenting a Summer Lecture Series. It's free to the public though a donation to the Fall River Historical Society would be appreciated. The first presentation is **THIS TUESDAY, JULY 9.** The title is: “River Rocks - Landmarks, Stones and Stories” presented by Bill Goncalo. It will examine local stone landmarks - some familiar, some more obscure - bringing to life their stories through photos, local history texts and personal recollections. The next presentation will be on **TUESDAY, JULY 16** entitled “Downtown Fall River: From Sleepy Crossroads to Bustling City Center”, presented by Bob Kitchen. It will cover the evolution of “downtown” from its early days as simply a sleepy crossroads to the main commercial center of the city. The third presentation will be on **TUESDAY, JULY 23.** It is called “Murderous Southcoast: 1826-2016 - 190 years of Murder, Manslaughter and Mayhem.” It will explore many of the Fall River area murders over the past 190 years. It will be presented by Dr. Stefani Koorey. The final presentation of the season will be on **TUESDAY, JULY 30.** It is called “Could It Be That Fall River's Finest Year Was 1953? Let's See”. The presentation will be given by Dr. Philip Silvia, Jr. and will reflect on “Appreciating a sweet time when civic pride, a caring spirit, and a purpose defined our community.” **ALL PRESENTATIONS WILL START AT 6:30 P.M. IN ROOM C-111.**

HOLY NAME FAITH FORMATION

PARENTS OF CHILDREN ENTERING FIRST GRADE THIS FALL, (IN EITHER PAROCHIAL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL) are asked to call our **FAITH FORMATION OFFICE** at **508-678-7532.** We will put you on our mailing list regarding your child's preparation to **receive First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Holy Communion.** This preparation **begins at the start of their 1st grade and goes for 2 years.** If you are not sure whether or not you are registered members of Holy Name Parish please call Diane at 508-679-6732. She will be able to help you.

ALL STUDENTS WHO WILL BE IN GRADES 2 & 9 NEXT YEAR who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **NEXT YEAR** must **sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon),** whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well). If you attend Mass at another Catholic Church on a particular weekend, you must ask the priest who celebrates that Mass to sign a bulletin for you and bring it to Mr. McNabb at the Faith Formation Office at school. **THIS APPLIES TO ALL STUDENTS IN THESE GRADES REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY ATTEND SCHOOL.**
