FAITH FORMATION

REGISTRATION PACKETS FOR FAITH FORMATION CLASSES were recently mailed. If you had a child registered in Faith Formation **last year** and **did not receive a packet in the mail**, please contact Dorothy Mahoney-Pacheco at the Faith Formation Office (508-678-7532), so one can be mailed to you. Parents of students entering Grades 1 or 8 **in any school (Catholic, Public, Private)**, if you did not receive a registration packet, please contact Dorothy to have your child(ren) placed onto the mailing data base so they can be registered in the Faith Formation Program to **begin a TWO YEAR** program of preparation for First Penance and First Holy Eucharist, or Confirmation.

PARENTS OF CHILDREN ENTERING FIRST GRADE THIS FALL, (IN EITHER PAROCHIAL OR PUBLIC SCHOOL) are asked to call our **FAITH FORMATION OFFICE** at **508-678-7532**. We will put you on our mailing list regarding your child’s preparation to **receive First Reconciliation (Confession) and First Holy Communion**. This preparation **begins at the start of their 1st grade and goes for 2 years**. If you are not sure whether or not you are registered members of Holy Name Parish please call Diane at 508-679-6732. She will be able to help you.

ALL STUDENTS WHO WILL BE IN GRADES 2 & 9 NEXT YEAR who wish to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Holy Eucharist and/or Confirmation **NEXT YEAR** must **sign into Mass each Sunday (or Sat. afternoon)**, whether there is class or not (this includes all vacation times as well). If you attend Mass at another Catholic Church on a particular weekend, you must ask the priest who celebrates that Mass to sign a bulletin for you and bring it to Ms. Mahoney-Pacheco at the Faith Formation Office at school. **THIS APPLIES TO ALL STUDENTS IN THESE GRADES REGARDLESS OF WHERE THEY ATTEND SCHOOL.**
