We will also be repointing the chimneys on the rectory and putting snow guards on the roof of the church to protect against giant icicles forming and then potentially breaking off. A REMINDER FOR THOSE WHO RECEIVE HOLY COMMUNION IN THE HAND. Please remember to make a **throne for Our Lord** by placing one hand over the other, allowing the priest, deacon or Extraordinary minister of Holy Communion to **place the Host in the palm of your hand.** Then, you should consume the Host and make the sign of the cross before proceeding back to your pew. Please do not “take” or “grab” the Host from the minister but receive it in the palm of your hand.
