ANNUAL PARISH APPEAL

GETTING TOWARDS THE END. OUR ANNUAL PARISH COLLECTION is well underway. Over the past years, through the generosity of those who donate to the Appeal, we have been able to undertake some extraordinary repairs to our buildings and property as well as be pro-active in providing for cost-saving measures for the good of our parish. This year we have already had some work done on the roof of the Rectory, we have repointed the stairs of the church, and painted the exterior doors of the church. In the Spring we will be painting the exterior of the church and siding the rectory. We will also be repointing the chimneys on the rectory and putting snow guards on the roof of the church to protect against giant icicles forming and then potentially breaking off. All of this is able to be done **because of the generosity of those who donated.** Returns can be made through the collection basket, by mail, or by dropping it off at the Parish Office (located in the Rectory). **If each family does its fair share, we will have another SUCCESSFUL APPEAL.** As of January 8, we have received a **total of \$49,779.00 from 230 families.** We still have a ways to go to surpass last year’s total of **\$50,010.00.
