**AS WE HAVE ENTER INTO THE “ORDINARY TIME” OF OUR CHURCH’S YEAR,** remember as Catholics, **WE HAVE THE PRIVILEGE AND RESPONSIBILITY TO PARTICIPATE IN MASS EVERY SUNDAY (or Sat. afternoon at the Vigil Mass).** This is because Jesus told us: **“DO THIS IN MEMORY OF ME.”** It is a serious sin to miss Mass on Sunday or a Holyday of Obligation for reasons other than sickness. If you have missed Mass **you should receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) BEFORE receiving Holy Communion.** Please see our schedule for Confessions or call Fr. Jay for an appointment if you can’t make it at the regular time.

**A REMINDER TO THOSE WHO RECEIVE COMMUNION IN THE HAND.** Please remember to make a **throne for Our Lord** by placing one hand over the other, allowing the priest, deacon or Extraordinary minister of Holy Communion to **place the Host in the palm of your hand.** Then you should consume the Host and make the sign of the cross before proceeding back to your pew. Please do not “take” or “grab” the Host from the minister but receive it in the palm of your hand.
