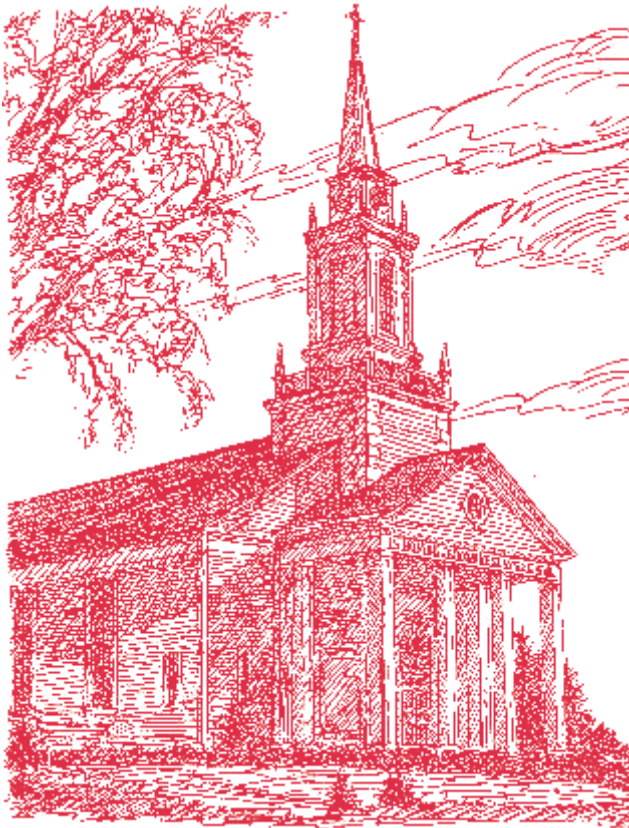

We ask that you keep a **SAFE DISTANCE FROM EACH OTHER** while picking up your palm leaf.

**FASTING AND ABSTAINING FROM MEAT DURING LENT:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fasting. Those 14 and older are obliged to observe the **Law of Abstinence from Meat on Good Friday**.
